Fees, charges, and fees are determined by regulations issued by the Ministry of Transport pursuant to the Ports and Waters Act of June 21, 2019.

1. Harbour dues

If vessels are on public docks, they will also pay a quay fee as well compensation/fee for renovation, electricity, water etc.

Special harbour dues

Vessels in shipping within the port district and surrounding waters such as pilot boats, tugs and vessels used as lodging / residence pay annual fees according to the following rates:

Harbour dues for fishing vessels

Fishing vessels will pay harbour dues for use of the public harbours at the following rates

Vessels between 15-21 meters	NOK 79,- pr call
Vessels between 21-28 meters	NOK 100,- pr call
Vessels larger than 28 meters	NOK 118,- pr call

The harbour due can only be charged for a maximum of 9 calls per month per vessel.

Season fee: Harbour dues will be paid for a maximum of 9 calls per vessel per season during the Lofoten fishery.

2. Quay fee

Storage Fee for Overstaying Goods

Goods unloaded at public quays may remain free of charge for up to 48 hours after unloading. If the goods require storage beyond this period, a fee of NOK 6 per occupied square meter per day will be applied. For transit and through-traffic goods, half of the above rates will be charged after the initial 48 hours.

9. EPI: (Environmental Port Index)

EPI is a sophisticated web-based reporting tool designed to measure emissions from ships when they visit a port. The tool has been developed by several Norwegian cruise ports with support from DNV. The purpose of EPI is to promote environmentally friendly shipping through economic incentives.

EPI has been implemented in Leknes Port to provide an economic incentive for sustainable and environmentally friendly cruise operations, and to make it less profitable to arrive at the port with polluting vessels.

Starting from January 1, 2024, Leknes Port will invoice cruise arrivals with a surcharge or discount on quay fees based on the EPI score.

Based on reported data, an EPI score between 0 (lowest) and 100 (highest) will be calculated, with the zero point for the EPI score set at 45.

Cruise ships must report data from their visit via the EPI portal no later than 72 hours after departure. If the EPI is not reported, the fee will be calculated based on a score of 0.

The following formulas are used for calculation:

Surcharge	$-20/9 \times \text{EPI-score} + 100$
Discount	$\text{Rabatt} = -24/55 \times \text{EPI-score} + (216/11)$

10. General

- Interest and reminder fees are applicable for delayed payments.
- All prices are stated excluding VAT.
- The port administration has the authority to enter into specific agreements regarding discount schemes on port fees to encourage increased activity in the ports.
